


# UNISSULA INTERNATIONAL MOSLEM SCHOLARSHIP 2024

SULTAN AGUNG ISLAMIC UNIVERSITY (UNISSULA), INDONESIA







#### A. BACKGROUND

Sultan Agung Islamic University (UNISSULA) is a leading Islamic university in Indonesia, located in central Java province. It was established in 1962 under the *Sultan Agung Waqf Foundation*. As one of the best Islamic private university in Indonesia, UNISSULA consciously involves in the effort to revive Islamic civilization. In line with the tagline "*Bismillah raising Khaira Ummah generation*", UNISSULA takes on the role by preparing generations of future leaders through world-class academic activities, research, and community service.

## **B. ELIGIBILITY**

The prospective student should meet the following criteria:

- This scholarship is only eligible for Moslem students.
- Prospective students are not Indonesian citizen (proved by passport)
- Currently not enrolled in other higher education institution (Universities, Colleges, etc.).
- Having good English communication is preferable
- Willing to learn Indonesian language as the medium of study

#### G. LIVING IN SEMARANG

Semarang is the capital and largest city of Central Java province in Indonesia. It has an area of 373.78 km2 (144.32 sq mi) and is located at 6°58′S 110°25′E. The population of the city is approximately 1.8 million people, making it Indonesia's seventh most populous city after Jakarta, Surabaya, Bandung, Bekasi, Medan, and Tangerang. The city has been named as the cleanest tourist destination in Southeast Asia by the ASEAN Clean Tourist City Standard (ACTCS) for 2020–2022.

Semarang features a tropical rainforest climate that borders on a tropical monsoon climate. The city features distinctly wetter and drier months, with June through August being the driest months. However, the average monthly rainfall does not fall below 60 mm (2.4 in), hence the tropical rainforest categorization. Semarang on average sees approximately 2,800 mm (110 in) of rain annually. Average temperatures in the city are relatively consistent, hovering around 28 °C (82 °F). Temperature variance does increase a little in the dry season, including July, where it has both the hottest and coldest temperatures, but the average temperature stays the same.
