

The 2025-2026 Hubert H. Humphrey Fellowship Program for Mid-Career Professionals

The Moroccan-American Commission for Educational & Cultural Exchange (MACECE) is now accepting applications for the 2025-2026 Hubert H. Humphrey Fellowship Program.

This one-year, non-degree, fellowship program is offered to mid-career professionals from the public and private sectors working at the policy level who have a demonstrated record of leadership and a commitment to public service. The program seeks to foster an ex-change of knowledge and mutual understanding between U.S. citizens and their professional counterparts from Morocco.

Fellows are based at leading American universities for 10 months to pursue self-designed programs to include independent study, coursework, and an internship with an organization in their field of expertise. Humphrey Fellows cannot transfer from non-degree status to degree status under any circumstances.

Applicants for the Humphrey Fellowship must meet all the following criteria: Have a bachelor's degree.

Have five years of substantial professional experience in their field. Have demonstrated leadership qualities and record of public service. Have a good level of English.

All applications are reviewed by a local selection panel.

The final selection of Fellows is made by the J. William Fulbright Foreign Scholarship Board.

Awards are announced by March each year for Fellowships beginning in August.
